Late Summer – Okauchee Lake

September 16 Fishing: 7am - 12:30pm)

[Okauchee Lake public boat launch](#) is on the southwest end of Okauchee Lake at the end of Road T off Wisconsin Ave in Okauchee, WI. A limited amount of free parking is available. Please [RSVP](#) to help plan for coffee and breakfast snacks that will be available at the launch until 7:00am. We will meet at the Hideaway Bar & Grill at the end of fishing hours (and through the day as you wish).

Okauchee Lake is 26 miles (just under 30 minutes) from the Milwaukee County Zoo. Factor your travel time from there.

Directions: I94 West to Hwy 16 West then take exit 176. Go right/north 1 block then right on Wisconsin Ave to Rd T left to the launch / parking lot.

Fall - Lake Waubesa

October 7 Fishing: 7am - 3:30pm

[Lake Farm County Park Launch](#)

(3113 Libby Road, Madison, WI) is on the Northwest shore of Lake Waubesa. Plenty of parking at this pay launch. Please [RSVP](#) to help plan for coffee and breakfast snacks that will be available at the launch until 7am. **Grills will be hot and ready for a short lunch break at 11:30 a.m.** so bring your own brats, dogs, etc. to grill before heading back out for the 1:30-3:30pm solar major.

Lake Farm County Park is approximately 60 miles and one hour from Highway T (Waukesha) at HWY 94. Factor your travel time from there.

Directions: I-94 W to I-90 East to Hwy 12/18 West to Towne Dr / Raywood Rd south to Moorland Rd to Lake Farm Road to Libby Rd to Lake Farm County Park boat launch.

Honor System - must share picture though! Measure your catch to the ¼ inch! Awards based on length. Junior and Adult Champion Awards based on length with tie breaker (if necessary) going to biggest girth.

- Live bait is allowed.
- Wisconsin Fishing regs apply.
- No trolling.
- Only one award possible per fish.
- Eligible fish must be caught during times posted for each event.
- Register fish by 10 minutes after fishing hours end time.
- Winners announced 15 minutes after fishing hours end time

Award Categories:

Junior Members (17 and under):

- Longest panfish
- Longest pike
- Longest bass
- Longest muskie (any size!)
 - Junior Champion

Adult Members:

- Longest Muskie (any size!)
 - Adult Champion

Awards:

The winner of each category will receive a certificate or plaque (for muskie awards) at the MCW Awards Banquet in March 2018 plus winners will be recognized in a future **MCW Release** newsletter, on our MCW website, and other social media.

Random Lake is 43 miles (just under an hour) from the Milwaukee County Zoo. Factor your travel time from there.

Directions: I94 east to I43 north to Hwy 57 north to Hwy K west to Hickory Drive east then immediate left on Russell Drive and right into the launch / parking lot.
